I am Koji Ishikawa from Showa University School of Medicine, Tokyo, Japan. It was my great honour to grant the AO Spine fellowship at the Scientific Education and Research Foundation (SERI) & The Center for Spine and Orthopedics, Denver, Colorado, USA. My stay in Denver, Colorado was definitely satisfying! First, I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to all the staffs related to this fellowship. All the staffs of SERI were very kind and they were willing to help me all the time including my daily life.

Dr. Michael Janssen, who is my supervisor, is an outstanding spine surgeon as a Ex-AO Spine Chairman. At the same time he was sportsman beyond my imagination and he has won the world champion of powerboat several time. I also had a chance to learn medicine from Dr. Joseph Morreale who is a co-supervisor and Dr. Christiana Ottomeyer who is a spine fellow. Dr. Morreale was a great spine surgeon in that his

Even though I was not familiar with these surgeries, Dr. Janssen and Dr. Morreale gave me instructions about the detail of operation in every case, and thanks to their advices, I could understand about the surgery very well. I also enjoyed the clinics, discussions, journal club, physician's meeting, lecture by Dr. Janssen at international spine meeting. Furthermore, Dr. Janssen was very nice and he invited me the trip to Missouri, Wyoming, and Nevada (attend the meeting). It was very memorable, and it impressed me all the time.

In daily life, I would like to thank everyone for the support to my family for the wonderful time in Denver. It couldn't be better without their support. I am glad that our family could cerebrate my son's birthday party at Denver with my neighbourhood. The thanksgiving party invited by Dr. Morreale was one of my best memory for my family.
